(Abu Dhabi, UAE: 20 January 2019): Encouraging opportunities within the country’s growing creative and cultural industries, the Abu Dhabi Music & Arts Foundation (ADMAF) invites Emirati artists and visual arts practitioners to submit their entries for **The Gulf Capital – Abu Dhabi Festival Visual Arts Award** and **The Gulf Capital – ADMAF Creativity Award** as part of the Abu Dhabi Festival 2019. The prestigious awards aim to shine a light on the country’s creative young talent by awarding the winners with AED10,000 and exhibiting their work at this and next year’s Abu Dhabi Festival.

The Princely Collections. This will include permanent loans from The Hohenbuchau Collection and other private collections, exhibited for the first time in the Middle East. The exhibition will run from 26 February – 25 March 2019 at Manarat Al Saadiyat, Gallery S. Applicants are invited to create a visual artwork, across any medium, that is inspired by the artworks in this exhibition.

Meanwhile, **The Gulf Capital – ADMAF Creativity Award 2019** invites young creativity in literature – the genres are poetry, drama, prose, non-fiction and media. Open to Emirati nationals



aged 18 to 35 years old, the award’s criteria are based on artistic merit, evidence of original and creative thinking and personal application of technical skills. Applicants are invited to submit their entries by 31st January 2019 via abudhabifestival.ae.
