During Abu Dhabi Art, the ADMAF Pavilion welcomed local, regional and international media, resulting in extensive coverage on television, radio, online and in print magazines and newspapers. More than 40 feature articles were published across all media in both Arabic and English, with outlets including The National, Al Ittihad, Kaleej Times, The Gulf Today, Abu Dhabi World and Emarat Television.

The results were impressive, with a reach of more than 115,000, engagement of over 6,200 unique users and in excess of 1,500 live video views.
